MISSION TO THE ELDERS

We held meetings for the Elders in Bahati and Nakuru Town (Nakuru County) and Tharaka Nithi. During Nakuru Bahati Mission, more than 170 Elders attended while in another Nakuru Elderly Mission, more than 130 elders were ministered to. During the second Nakuru meeting in Nakuru Wanyororo B and Rigogo Mission, we visited more than 30 homes, prayed, and reconciled them: husband and wives, children and Parents. We went door to door and donated food, and blankets.

MINISTERING TO THE YOUTH

The young people were also ministered to. During the Ruiru Youth Mission, we ministered to more than 170 boys and girls from poor families and visited the less fortunate families and donated foodstuffs. We held another meeting at Victoria Secondary School where more than 80 boys and girls attended and were ministered to. We also held a two-day camp at Thika to heal and restore the youth. Twenty-Five (25 girls) from vulnerable backgrounds attended and ministered to.
